Both report cards provide information concerning student performance on the State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness (STAAR®) from the 2018-19 school year, as well as information on enrollment, class size averages, and financial expenditures. SAT/ACT participation, average SAT score, and average ACT score are also indicators in the TEA accountability system.
