Austin ISD Superintendent and Board of Trustees issued a <u>statement</u> on the killings of George Floyd and Mike Ramos at the June 2, 2020, board meeting. Bowie High School stands with the district in response to recent events in our city and nation. Tuesday, August 18, 2020, will be Austin ISD's first day of school of the fall semester. This is in line with the previously released 2020–21 academic calendar, selected through community input and approved by the Board of Trustees in January. The AISD reopening task force—which is composed of teachers, parents, staff, and community members from a variety of backgrounds—evaluated the possibilities of earlier or later start dates.

Further task force recommendations will be made with guidance from health officials and in consideration of aspects such as school capacity and social distancing. Coming into the fall semester of 2020, we may see inperson learning, an extension of continuous learning practices, or a blend of both approaches. If there is at-home learning in the fall, we will continue to gather and share information, as well as best practices to support student learning.

We do know that the task force is actively discussing possibilities, developing standards, and working to make the best determinations for students, teachers, and families. Please stay tuned to this newsletter as well as austinisd.org as decisions around reopening are made.

Finally, due to COVID-19, a Verification of Enrollment is not available at this time due to school closures. If you are unable to obtain a VOE statement this summer, the Texas Department of Public Safety has announced that other types of documents verifying enrollment such as a report card of student ID may be accepted.
