Austin ISD will also host an Enroll Austin Registration Clinic for families at AISD Central Office (4000 S. I-H 35 Frontage Rd, Austin, 78704) in the Board Auditorium on Saturday, January 27, 2024 from 9:00am - 12:00pm. Families will receive one-on-one support of the new registration process. Representatives from the departments of Enrollment and Attendance, Multilingual Education, Early Learning, Communication and Community Engagement will be on-site to support families.

EVERYONE:1 STUDENT DEVICE FEEDBACK - AISD Technology remains committed to providing students the devices they need to fully participate in blended learning environments. However, the warranties do not cover loss or intentional damage, an increasing issue the district is experiencing. The additional costs associated with device loss and damage incurred have drained bond funds, which threaten the sustainability of the Everyone:1 program. The district has reviewed the internal student device loss and damage incident data and now needs feedback from staff and families to inform next steps. The Everyone:1 Student Device Feedback Survey is open to faculty, staff, and AISD families until February 1. Please note at this time, the survey is not intended to be completed by students.
