SCHOOL-DAY SAT - On Tuesday, March 5, all juniors will take an official School-Day SAT. There is no cost and students are automatically registered. Students are encouraged to bring a personal or borrowed calculator, preferably a graphing calculator, to the test (Bowie does not have enough loaner calculators to supply one to every junior). Students will have short stretch breaks and restroom breaks between the timed sections of the test, but will not be released for lunch until the test administration has been completed around 1:15 pm. Therefore, it's a good idea for all juniors to bring a bottle of water and a light snack, such as a granola bar or crackers, to their test site. Additionally, please remind your junior that in order to receive their SAT scores from College Board, it is important that they provide a **personal email address** (NOT their AISD email address) when they complete the College Board preregistration forms on Tuesday morning in their test sites.

TSI EXAM - Freshmen and sophomores are scheduled to take the TSI exam on March 5 as the juniors take the SAT. The TSI exam is one of the ways that students can meet the State's college-readiness standard, and many colleges and universities use it for course placement. Because the TSI exam includes lots of 8th grade content, students are positioned to be successful on it even as underclassmen. Additionally, by taking it earlier in high school, students wanting to take ACC dual credit classes will have already met the TSI requirements for ACC admission.

MARCH 5 SENIOR ACTIVITIES - March 5 is a great day for seniors to opt for a College Visit! Seniors are allowed two excused absence days for a documented College Visit. This type of absence does not negatively affect the students' opportunity to earn attendance incentives as long as the necessary documentation is submitted. Seniors who are on campus on March 5 have scheduled activities as the other grade levels test. Seniors who have already met their TSI assessment requirement will participate in enrichment activities, including hearing from Bowie Alumni, getting a preview for Bowie's Got Talent (featuring some fellow classmates and some teachers!), hearing from a guest speaker, and more. Seniors who still need to meet the requirement for the TSI will be scheduled to take the assessment in a classroom.
