**SOLAR ECLIPSE** - On April 8, we will be together to experience a historic event as we are in the direct path of a total solar eclipse! Second period teachers will deliver a lesson to students about safe viewing as well as distribute safety glasses. During 3rd period, teachers will escort their students to designated viewing areas around campus for the total eclipse moment! *Parents, guardians, and student drivers: please be mindful of extra traffic on this day since many travelers will likely be driving into the Austin area for the viewing*.

STAAR EOC ADMINISTRATION - All 10<sup>th</sup> grade students will take the English II STAAR End Of Course Exam on Thursday, April 11, and all 9<sup>th</sup> grade students will take the English I STAAR End Of Course Exam on Friday, April 12. Testing will begin each morning at 9:05am and will end at 1:23pm for most students. All students not participating in testing will follow their regular schedule of classes, although some classes may need to be relocated or have substitute teachers to accommodate for state standardized testing. Students will need their FULLY CHARGED AISD CHROMEBOOK to access the testing platform. We also encourage students who are testing to bring a sack lunch in case they test through their lunch period. Please remind your student to get a good night's sleep and eat a good breakfast on testing days! STAAR End of Course Exams for US History, Biology, and Algebra I will take place in the following weeks.

**ACC FREE TUITION PILOT PROGRAM** - The ACC Free Tuition pilot program provides free tuition and general fees for high school grads and GED completers who live in the <u>ACC service area</u>. This includes students from all high schools in the ACC service area, including local school districts and charter schools, as well as home school programs. The program will launch in fall 2024. It starts with students from the class of 2024 and will continue for all future classes in subsequent years for the next 5 years.

## WHAT'S INCLUDED

- Students who are eligible for the program will receive FREE tuition and general fees at ACC for 3 years or up to 5 years if they want to pursue a bachelor's degree at ACC.
- \$85 per credit hour includes:
  - \$67 Resident Tuition
