## Greetings, Bulldog Nation!

We hope your family had a restful break, and we're excited to welcome our students back for a great second semester. We also want to take a moment to remind families to periodically check the Bowie website at <a href="mailto:bowie.austinschools.org">bowie.austinschools.org</a> for information and updates.

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP CONCERNS - Our local apartment communities have contacted us regarding concerns about Bowie student and parent use of their parking facilities during drop-off and pick-up times. Non-resident Bowie cars have been parking in their guest and residents' spaces at the end of the school day and then becoming non-compliant when they are asked to move. Additionally, dozens of students enter the complex beyond the gates to wait to be picked up, and non-resident cars have tailed residents to enter the gates and retrieve their students. It is imperative that Bowie students and parents do not use the nearby apartment parking lots to circumvent the drop-off and pick-up loop at the front of the campus. Thank you for helping us maintain good relations with our neighbors and keeping our campus safe by respecting the established protocols for traffic and parking.

**ACCOMMODATIONS FOR AP EXAMS** - If your student receives accommodations through their 504 or IEP, testing accommodations must be approved by the College Board before the AP Exams. The deadline to request accommodations for AP Exams is January 15. Students only need to complete this process once throughout high school; approved accommodations follow them year to year for AP Exams. **AP EXAM REGISTRATION** - If you have a student enrolled in a Spring-Semester Only Advanced Placement course, students will have an opportunity to receive college credit by taking the AP Exam. AP Registration will only be open for students currently enrolled in AP United States Government, AP Comparative Government, AP Macroeconomics, and AP Microeconomics. AP Exam Registration will open on February 3. A \$40.00 late fee will be applied starting February 23. AP Exam Registration will close by 11:59 pm on March 7.

AP Exam Registration consists of two parts. First, students must be enrolled in their teacher's AP Classroom with the College Board. Secondly, registration and payment must take place in Total Registration. For more information and details about AP Exam Registration, please visit our <a href="website">website</a>. **CHARACTER STRONG -** Austin ISD is excited to announce the adoption of <u>Character Strong</u>, an evidence-based, multi-tiered solution to support whole child success. Character Strong is a program that provides character development curricula from Pre-K through 12th grade. It is used by schools in all 50 states and 47 different countries, serving over 6.7 million students across the globe.

Starting on Monday, January 13, students will begin participating in Character Strong lessons during FIT. All students will report to their 3rd period teacher's classroom for FIT every Monday for the duration of the semester as part of our campus commitment to Character Strong. Students received a brief overview about Character Strong and FIT expectations on the first day back to school after the winter break, and you can view that training video here.
