ADVANCED OPPORTUNITIES NIGHT - The Austin ISD Office of Advanced Academics is hosting a <u>virtual information session</u> that will highlight multiple advanced pathways and opportunities across the district on Tuesday, November 12, from 6 -7 pm. <u>The session will take place in English on Google Meet</u>. Other languages will be available through closed captions in Google Meet.

AP EXAM REGISTRATION - If you have a student enrolled in an Advanced Placement course, students will have an opportunity to receive college credit by taking the AP Exam. AP Exam Registration for Year-Long and Fall-Semester courses began on Monday, September 30. After October 28, there will be a \$40 late fee applied to each AP Exam. AP Exam Registration will close on November 10, 2024. Any student enrolled in a Spring-Semester Only course will have an opportunity to register for that course's AP Exam in the spring semester.

AP Exam Registration consists of two parts. First, students must be enrolled in their teacher's AP Classroom with College Board. Students wishing to invite a non-Bowie guest must pick up a Guest Approval Form (printed on bright yellow paper) from the school front office and submit it to Assistant Principal Christina Burbank, along with a photocopy of the guest's school ID. The deadline is 4:30 p.m. on Monday, October 21, 2024. Guest Wristbands will be issued at the event only for pre-approved guests. Guests will also need to have their student IDs with them for check-in to get a wristband. Guest wristbands will only be sold at the door to pre-approved guests- NO EXCEPTION).
