ENROLL AUSTIN - Austin ISD's new unified enrollment system, <u>Enroll Austin</u>, is set to launch on November 8, 2023! The new system will make registration more accessible and equitable by simplifying the registration process, saving families time, and helping families better understand and access their school options. For the 2024-25 enrollment cycle, the new system will consolidate the following applications into one streamlined system: Online Registration (Frontline), Online Student Transfer Request, Common Application and Pre-K Application. NATIONAL YOUTH HOMELESS AWARENESS MONTH - November is National Youth Homeless Awareness Month. Over 93,000 students in Texas are experiencing homelessness and as of October 2023, 920 students have been identified as "homeless" in AISD. In Austin ISD, <u>Project HELP</u> staff serves over 1,300 students per year who experience some form of homelessness or housing instability. During the month of November 2023, AISD campus and district staff are encouraged to remain aware of the silent traumas that students who are homeless or unsheltered experience and encourage anyone you know who may need assistance to reach out.

DIWALI - Students will not attend classes on November 13, 2023 for the observance of Diwali. Diwali is known as the Festival of Lights. Diwali is a Hindu observance celebrated throughout the world. Festivities include the illumination of lights, candles, firecrackers, and diya (clay lamps) to symbolize the victory of good over evil, inner light over spiritual darkness, and knowledge over ignorance. Diwali is a time for gathering with loved ones, celebrating life, and committing to making the right decisions in life.
