ADDITIONAL PARKING PERMITS - The marching band practice lot will open for student parking on November 27, 2023. In advance of this date, Bowie will sell additional Lot A permits that allow students to park in the marching band lot or in the small surface lot next to the opposite side of the parking garage. **Online Lot A permit sales will begin at 9:00 am on Monday, November 20, 2023.** Permits will be sold to juniors and seniors ONLY for \$75 on a first come, first served basis. Students will not be allowed to trade a current permit for a different spot.*

PSAT SCORES - PSAT 8/9 and PSAT/NMSQT scores are available this week! Students may view scores on <u>BigFuture School</u>. If your student provided their mobile number on test day, they will receive a text message with access to the <u>BigFuture School mobile app</u>. Students may also access scores online using their personal College Board account. Reference the <u>College Board's website</u> to learn about the many ways knowing PSAT scores can be helpful to your student. If your student is unable to access their personalized College Board account, please contact the College Board help desk at 866-630-9305.

AP EXAM ACCOMMODATIONS - If your student is taking an AP Exam in May 2024 and receives school-based accommodations, College Board requires students to apply for their accommodations on their AP Exam. **Students do not automatically receive accommodations on their AP Exams.** This process is only required once throughout high school. If you have already gone through this process, you do not need to do so again. However, if you have not applied for College Board accommodations, the parent must initiate a request for their student to receive accommodations on an AP Exam.
