REPORT CARDS - Official grade reports sharing your student's 2nd 9 weeks grades, final exam grades, and fall semester averages will be available via the parent portal by Thursday, January 17, 2025.

LEVEL CHANGE REQUESTS - Those students wishing to adjust the level of rigor in a course by moving from the advanced to the academic level for the spring semester must complete this threestep process by **January 5**, **2025 at 5:00 pm**: (1) Discuss the desire to change levels with the teacher; (2) Submit the Level Change Form; and (3) Parent sends an email to the counselor confirming their consent to a possible schedule change. Teacher committees will review the individual merits of each request to move from an advanced to an academic-level course within the context of staffing, class size, and other factors. Level change requests are not automatically **approved or guaranteed**.

Students' spring semester 5th period classes will also be posted in front of the library when students return to campus to direct them to the correct classroom. We will have extended 5th period that day to check schedules and review expectations for FIT. Our normal FIT schedule will resume on Wednesday, January 8.

INCOMING 9TH GRADE SHOWCASE- From 5:30-7:00 pm on Monday, January 13, Bowie will host the Incoming 9th Grade Showcase. Current 8th grade students and new-to-Bowie incoming students of any grade-- along with their parents or guardians-- are invited to explore the Bowie campus!
