We encourage families to review this email together to ensure alignment with academic goals. At this time of year, many students inquire about summer course options. The two most common opportunities are:

- **Austin Community College (ACC):** Students interested in ACC courses should work with our College and Career Advisor, <u>Amber Luna</u>, for guidance on enrollment.
- **Garza High School Online:** Students can enroll in courses through the Garza High School Online <u>website</u>. Common summer course selections include Health, as well as Government and Economics for rising seniors.

If students have questions about their course selections, we encourage them to speak with their current teachers, who can provide valuable insights.
