AP EXAM REGISTRATION - If you have a student enrolled in a Spring-Semester Only Advanced Placement course, students will have an opportunity to receive college credit by taking the AP Exam. AP Registration will only be open for students currently enrolled in AP United States Government, AP Comparative Government, AP Macroeconomics, and AP Microeconomics. AP Exam Registration opened on February 3. **A \$40.00 late fee will be applied starting Monday, February 24.** AP Exam Registration will close by 11:59 pm on March 7.

AP Exam Registration consists of two parts. First, students must be enrolled in their teacher's AP Classroom with the College Board. MARCH 4 TESTING - All 11th grade students in Austin ISD will be taking the SAT School Day on Tuesday, March 4. The SAT School Day will be administered digitally, and it is important that each student brings their Chromebook to school on that day. The SAT School Day is paid for by the district, and no registration is required for this exam. This is a great opportunity for students to attempt the SAT free of charge.
