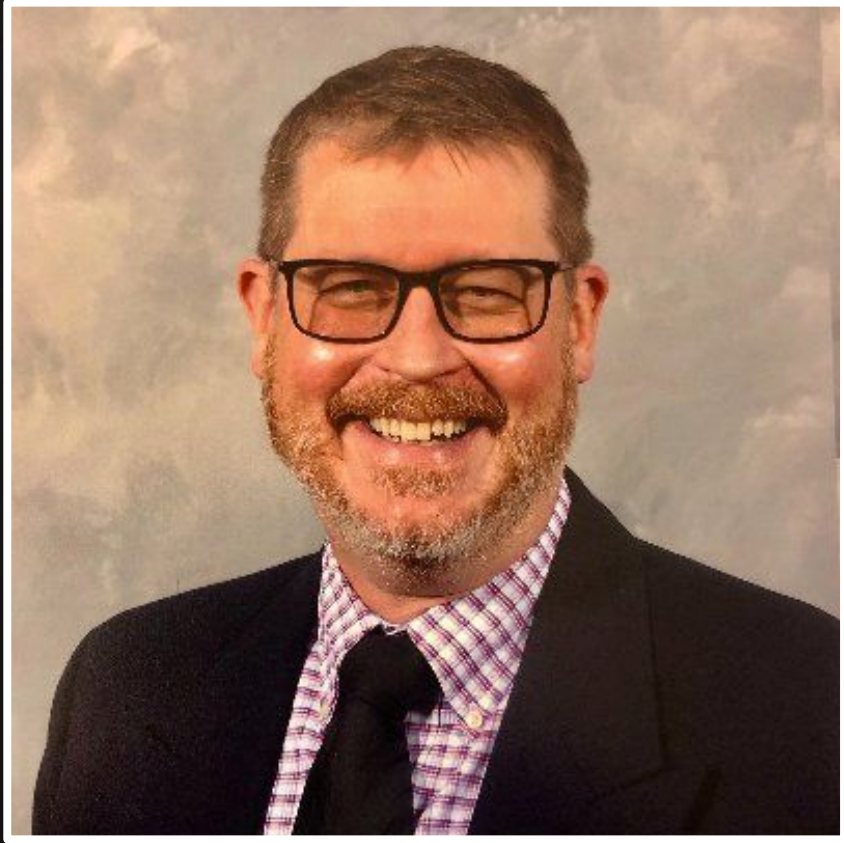

The mission of JBHS is to nurture all learners in their academic and career goals, social needs, and personal interests while celebrating diversity and preparing students for their futures.

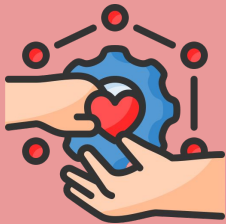
BOWIE HIGH SCHOOL VISION

HB 1481 – PERSONAL WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICES

List of Prohibited Devices

- Personal cell phones
- Tablets
- Gaming devices
- Smart watches
- Bluetooth headphones or earbuds
- Fitness trackers that can send or receive messages
- Personal (non-district-issued) computers
- Two-way radios
- Pagers
- Any other device capable of digital communication



For all Offenses:

- Campus personnel will direct students to give them the device.
- Students are required to comply with directives.*
- Campus personnel will take possession of the device and store in a designated location.
- Parents/Guardians will be notified
- The offense will be documented.

**AWAY
FOR THE
DAY**

1st Offense:

The **student** may pick up the device at the end of the school day after verifying ownership.

* If a student refuses to turn over the device, the action is considered insubordination and is a violation of the Student Success Guide. An administrator will be informed and additional disciplinary action may be taken.

2nd Offense:

Only a **parent/guardian** may pick up the device **at the end of the school day** after verifying ownership.

3rd Offense:

Only a **parent/guardian** may pick up the device **the next school day** after verifying ownership.

Matters.

- Written verification of the absence must be received by the school (recommended within 48 hours after the absence has occurred).
- Some absences require additional documentation such as a doctor's appointment and court hearings. Please **attach** along with school absence note.

Phone calls are not required to report an absence in advance, per policy we can't address absences in advance. The school **CANNOT** accept phone calls or voicemail messages as documentation for a student's absence.
