FIRST WEEK RECAP - We had a wonderful back to school week at James Bowie High School! To get all of our students acquainted (or reacquainted) with our systems and structures, we had on-boarding lessons in their Advisory classes during Flexible Instructional Time (FIT). This included a <u>welcome</u> <u>video</u> from our administration team, instruction regarding our <u>Attendance Incentive program</u>, an introduction to <u>AISD's Student Code of Conduct</u>, including educational materials about the hazards and consequences of vaping, a <u>how-to guide for FIT</u>, and a PSA about <u>Bowie's Baseline Expectations</u>, featuring some very special guests!

In addition to those lessons, part of our efforts to help our students feel that they belong at Bowie includes our second annual 9th grade Bulldog Spirit Training! This pep rally is designed with our freshmen in mind as a way to fully initiate them into Bulldog Nation. They learn the school song with our choir, their class yell with the cheerleaders and Silver Stars, meet their Class of 2027 sponsors, and connect with upperclassmen in various leadership roles across campus. CREDIT BY EXAM - Credit by examination (CBE) is one method for students to demonstrate proficiency in grade-level or course content. Secondary students may earn course credit towards graduation requirements. The Quarter 1 testing window for Credit by Exam occurs August 25 - September 8, 2023. **The Registration Deadline has been extended to Monday, August 21 by the end of the day**. FREE OR REDUCED LUNCH APPLICATIONS - Free or Reduced Meal Applications were distributed this week through your student's Advisory classes. It is a yellow application. If your family is interested in participating in this program, please complete the application and ask your student to return it to the front office. You may also apply for the application process online with <u>www.SchoolCafe.com/AustinISD</u>. Students that qualify for this program are eligible for reduced fees for college applications and standardized tests for college admissions.

DRIVING PASS - *This is only for students with valid Driver's Licenses* - To authorize a student to check out without a parent/guardian present, please fill out the **Driving Pass Request** Google form 24 hours in advance (the form will be open daily from 4:30 pm to 7:30 am).

- The student will receive a pass at their departure time. The student will need to come to the office to sign out and to pick up their "Permit to Leave" (driving pass) prior to leaving campus.
- Upon returning to campus, the student may sign themselves back in at the main office and drop off their excuse note to document the absence. Students will then be issued a pass to proceed to class.
