LEVEL CHANGE APPLICATION - Students who are considering a level change in one or more of their courses must submit an application between Monday, September 23 - Friday, September 27 by <u>completing this linked form</u>. Understand that level changes can only take place in courses that have another level counterpart. We have many advanced courses that do not have another option available, and therefore, there is no change available.

For students to be eligible for an application, students must have a conversation with their current teacher about their application, must have attended FIT/tutoring sessions, and must have all of their coursework submitted to be eligible to apply. All applications must be submitted by Friday, September 27, no later than 5:00 PM.

Committees will review the individual student applications while also reviewing availability in the academic level class. Please know that this is an application, and it is not automatically approved. Additionally, there is a high possibility your student's schedule will be changed to accommodate approved applications. Your student's counselor will inform them if your level change was

approved by emailing the new schedule on October 3. Teachers will inform your student if the request was denied.
