AP EXAM REGISTRATION - If you have a student enrolled in an <u>Advanced Placement course</u>, students will have an opportunity to receive college credit by taking the AP Exam. AP Exam Registration for Year-Long and Fall-Semester courses will begin on Monday, October 2. After October 31, there will be a \$40.00 late fee applied to each AP Exam. AP Exam Registration will close on November 10, 2023. Any student enrolled in a Spring-Semester Only course will have an opportunity to

PSAT DAY- On Wednesday, October 11, the digital PSAT 8/9 will be administered to 9th graders, and the digital PSAT/NMSQT will be administered to 10th and 11th graders. This means that your child will be taking the exam on a computer rather than using traditional pen and paper. To acclimate to the digital format and become comfortable with the tools they will be using during the exam, students can explore the <u>College Board's prep materials</u> online. It is imperative that students bring a fully charged Chromebook on Wednesday, October 11, in order to access the exam.
