UPCOMING PSAT & SAT DATES - The PSAT will be administered to registered freshmen on Friday, January 22, and registered sophomores and juniors on Tuesday, January 26. Registration for the PSAT is closed since tests had to be ordered from the College Board. Parents of students registered for the PSAT will receive an email in advance of the exam with detailed test-day instructions. If your child is not registered for the upcoming PSAT at Bowie, consider having them simulate the exam using one of the College Board's paper and pencil practice tests.

Austin ISD has contracted with the College Board to administer an official SAT to any interested 11th grade student. This SAT will be free to students and administered at Bowie on Wednesday, March 3. Bowie will email a sign-up Google Form to all juniors and their parents. Look for this important communication in the last week of January.

100% REMOTE & ASYNCHRONOUS LEARNING DAYS - Dr. Elizalde recently announced that there will be four days this spring of 100% district-wide remote asynchronous learning: January 29, February 26, March 5, and April 9. All students will engage in learning from home on these dates in order to give teachers work time and allow for a deep clean of the campus. To accommodate those teachers and students involved in upcoming on-campus PSAT & SAT testing, Bowie students will also participate in remote asynchronous learning on January 22, January 26, and March 3. Additional remote asynchronous learning dates may be added later in the spring for the administration of the STAAR End-of-Course Exams.
