STAAR EOC RESULTS: The Spring 2021 STAAR EOC exam scores will not be emailed or mailed to parents or guardians. Instead, parents and guardians can access their child's official score report via the AISD Parent Portal on or around **June 15, 2021**. The Communications Department will be posting information on the district's website and social media pages about how parents can access scores (the AISD parent portal will link directly to the state parent portal).

EOC scores do not impact a child's grade in the corresponding course, but per state law, all students are required to pass five STAAR End-of-Course (EOC) exams prior to graduation. Students will have multiple opportunities to retake the EOC exam, with the next opportunity scheduled for June 22-24 at Bailey Middle School.

Next week, Bowie's Summer EOC Testing Coordinator, Wendy Escobedo, will contact the parents of students eligible to make up or retake an EOC exam.
