JUNETEENTH PARADE: Austin ISD will celebrate Juneteenth by participating in the annual <u>Historical Juneteenth Parade</u> on Saturday, June 19, 2021. Students and staff are invited to march in the parade behind the AISD Juneteenth banner and the AISD All-Star Band. AISD participants will meet at the I-35 parade entrance at the intersection of MLK and Comal no later than 9 a.m. The parade route is approximately 1.2 miles. The parade will begin at 10 a.m. and end at approximately 11:30 a.m. Please see a <u>map of the route</u>. Participants are encouraged to wear comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen and to bring water. AISD ENROLLMENT PROJECT: AISD'S student enrollment goal for the first week of school is 79,351 students. As of last week, enrollment stood at 70,264 (not including this year's senior class), 39,206 of whom have registered for next year. In addition, the majority of AISD students ended the year learning remotely. Given the recent developments in the Texas Legislature, there is a possibility that AISD will need to transition approximately 35,000 students from learning virtually to in-person instruction the next school year. No final decisions have been made at the district level regarding offering a virtual option.

Please make sure your child is officially enrolled for next year! **If your student is returning to Bowie next year, please complete the registration process as soon as possible.** The online registration system is available through the <u>AISD Portal</u> at portal.austinisd.org. If you or someone you know needs assistance, encourage them to attend one of the <u>AISD Enrollment Events</u> scheduled throughout the summer at locations across Austin. Some data in the digital forms will be grayed and view-only. You will need to email Joanna Willard in our Data Processing office at joanna.willard@austinisd.org or contact her by phone at 512.414.7314 to make changes to these fields. All returning students who have had a recent change of address must submit proof of residency to their campus for the 2021-22 school year after August 1st.
