STUDENT FLU VACCINE CLINIC - To keep our students in school and learning, we want to avoid a severe flu season exacerbating the impact of Covid-19 on our community. In partnership with Austin ISD, Health Hero America is making the flu vaccine available to Bowie students on Wednesday, October 20 at Bowie. There is no out of pocket cost or copay. If you would like your child to participate in this on-campus flu vaccine clinic, please **fill out the Consent Form and return it to the main office by Wednesday, October 13**. **LOCKDOWN DRILL** - Please be aware that Bowie will be conducting two safety drills this week. There will be a fire drill for the Athletics Building ONLY on Wednesday, September 29 at the beginning of 3rd period (approximately 1:30 pm). We will also be conducting a whole campus lockdown drill on Thursday, September October 30 at the beginning of 8th period (approximately 3:06 pm). If your child has any particular sensitivities to safety drills, please advise them accordingly and/or contact your child's counselor as appropriate.

AP EXAM REGISTRATION - Advanced Placement courses give students the chance to tackle college-level work while they're still in high school. And through taking AP Exams at the end of the course, students can earn college credit and placement. AP Exam Registration opens on Monday, October 4 for students currently taking year-long and fall semester-long AP courses. The deadline to register and pay without a late fee is October 15. Otherwise, the absolute last day to register is November 11. Registration information for the spring semester-long courses will be provided in January 2022. Exam fee waivers are available to those students who qualify through the Income Verification Survey.

**INCOME VERIFICATION SURVEY** - Economically disadvantaged students are eligible to receive a variety of support services at school, including fee waivers for the SAT, ACT, and/or AP Exams. If you have not already done so, we encourage you to complete the Income Verification Survey as soon as possible. Austin ISD emailed your unique link to the Income Verification Survey on September 17, but the survey is also available to you in the AISD Parent Portal (<a href="https://portal.austinisd.org/">https://portal.austinisd.org/</a>). Please respond to the survey even if you have completed a paper form in the past. Survey responses are confidential.

**VIRTUAL PARENT WORKSHOP** - The Parent Engagement Support Office in partnership with the Austin ISD Brain Lab Team is offering a virtual workshop series to families around the Neurosequential Model in Education, or NME. Due to the collective trauma caused by the pandemic as well as the unprecedented rise in mental health issues, they want to make sure families are equipped with an understanding of the brain, as well as how to support their child at home.
