REPORT CARDS - Starting this school year, progress reports and standard report cards will be emailed to families and no longer be available in the student documentation tile in the parent portal. Instead, they will be distributed via a link in an email according to the 2025-2026 Report Card calendar. The first nine weeks grading period will end on Friday, October 17 and report cards will be sent out to families by Wednesday, November 4. As we approach the end of the grading period, this is a great time to check your student's grades in the Parent Portal and encourage them to finish strong!

AP EXAM REGISTRATION - If you have a student enrolled in an Advanced Placement course at this time, students will have an opportunity to receive college credit by taking the AP Exam. AP Exam Registration will open on

September 29, and will be open throughout the month of October. After October 31, a \$40.00 late fee will be applied to each exam. The absolute last day to register for your AP Exam is November 12. Any student enrolled in a Spring Semester-Only course will have an opportunity to register for that course's AP Exam in the spring semester.

AP Exam Registration consists of two parts: 1) Students must be enrolled in their teacher's AP Classroom with the College Board; and 2) Registration and payment must take place in Total Registration.
