



“Why would I need my immunization records after graduating high school?”

- Most colleges and many employers will require your immunization records
- If you don’t have your records, you might have to do blood tests to verify immunity and/or have some doses repeated

“How can I find my immunization records?”

- A parent/guardian
- Your healthcare provider and/or local health department:
 - This depends on where the vaccinations were administered (for example: doctor’s office, Austin Public Health, Walgreens/CVS pharmacy, etc.)
- A state immunization registry:
 - If the immunization records are in ImmTrac2, the Texas Immunization Registry, you can request a copy by calling the Texas Immunization Information Line at **1-800-252-9152**.
